


Indieflix Instructions

2. If you already have created an account for 'Zinio' magazines you can click Login as it is the same company (Skip to step # 6)

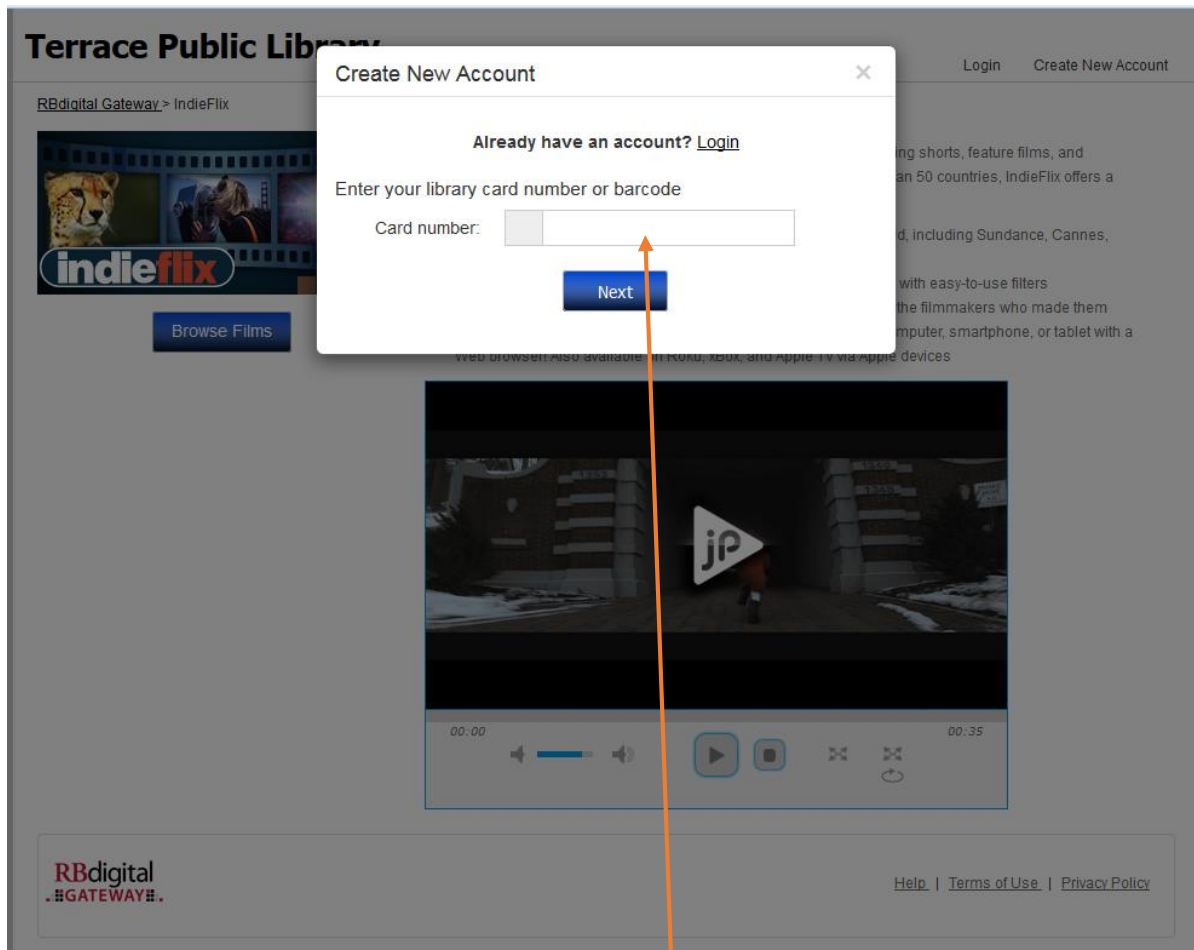

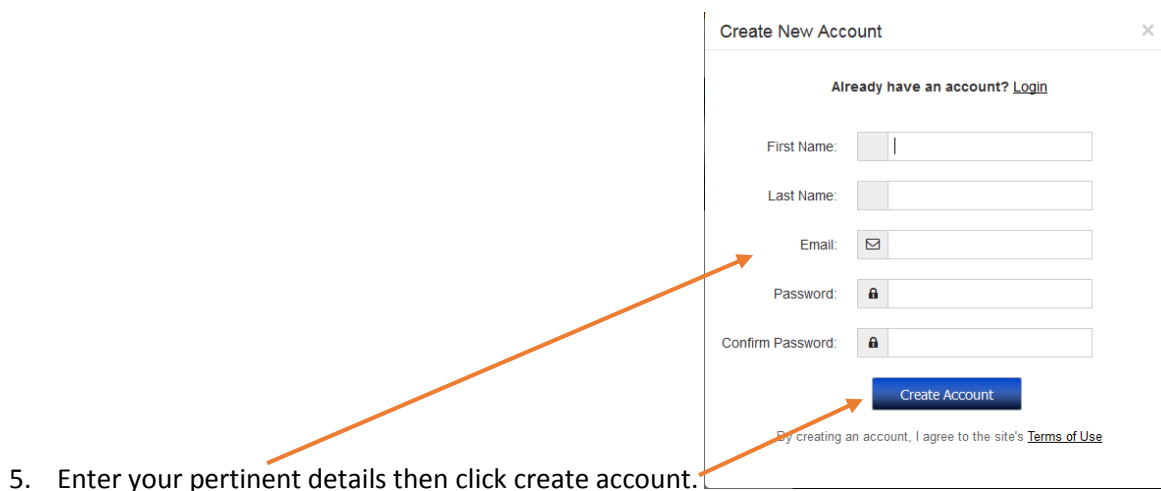

3. If you don't have an account you will need to create one by clicking Create New Account.



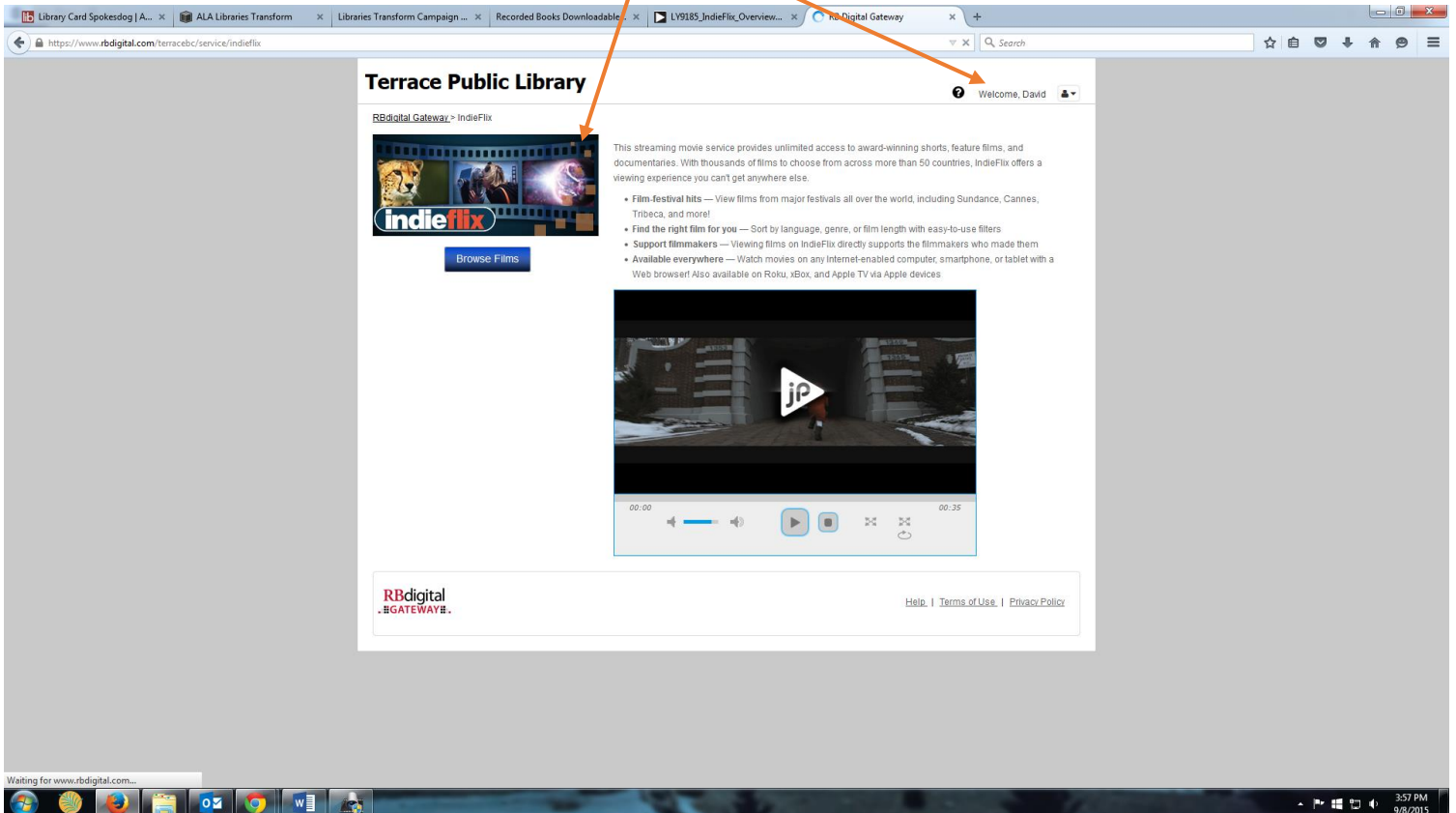
4. Enter your library card number in full (no spaces between the numbers).



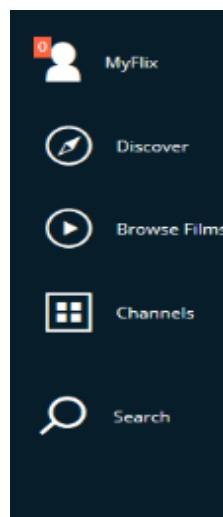
5. Enter your pertinent details then click create account.

* It will log you in automatically once you create the account and you will get a verification email once it is created.

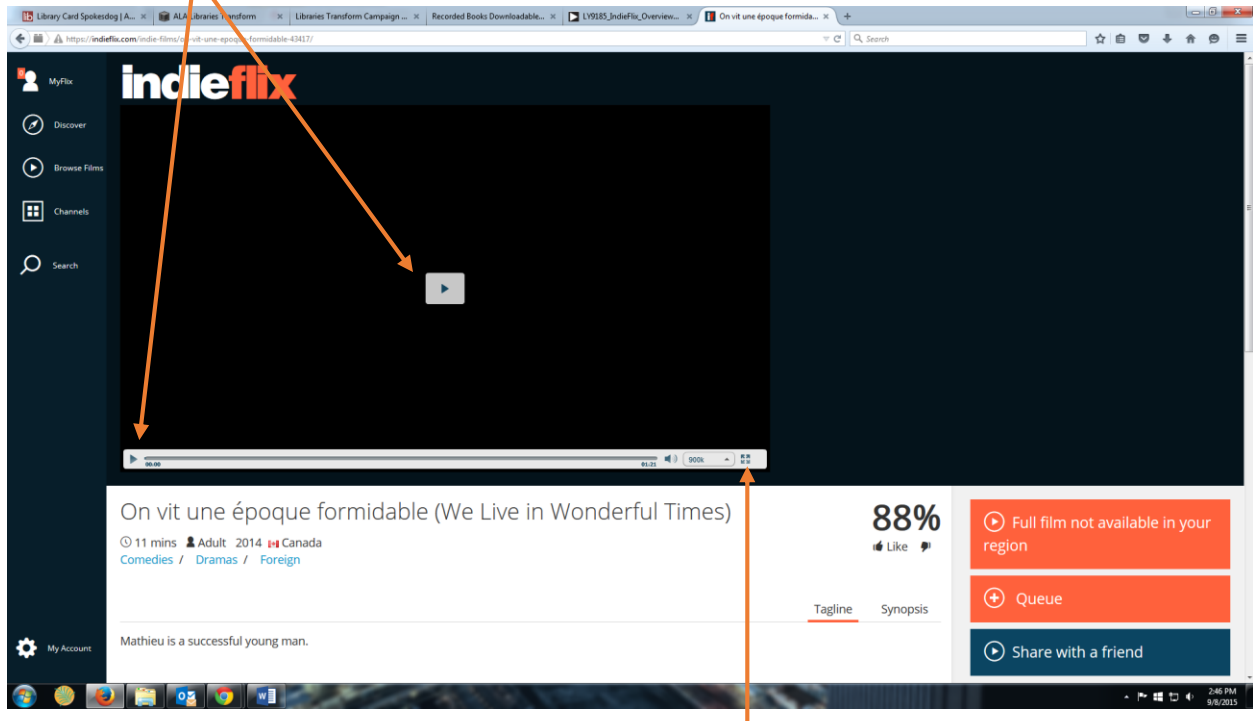
6. After you are logged in you can click the Indieflix picture/banner button on the left (below where it says “Terrace Public Library.” You will also see that you are logged in by looking in the top right hand corner. It will say : “Welcome your name here”



7. Then search for a movie, documentary or short film by browsing the ‘Channels’/categories or searching.



- Click the video you are interested in watching and then press the play button and it will start to stream.



* You can make the video full screen by click the full screen button in the bottom right of the video. (Press the 'Escape' key to get out of full screen).

* There is an Indieflix app for iPad and Android devices. Please do not use these apps for the account you created it will give you an error when you try to login through the app. You need to use a web browser on your table/phone/device or your computer to login. Please use this web address:

Instructions for AppleTV

You will need:

- AppleTV 2nd Generation
- An AirPlay enabled Apple device (<https://support.apple.com/en-ca/HT204289>)
- HDTV

1. Create an account following the instructions above.
2. Access IndieFlix through a web browser (i.e. Safari) and find a movie to watch.
3. Send it to your AppleTV with Airplay. AppleTV and the device should be on the same "home share" network (set in settings). Learn more at www.apple.com/airplay.

Instructions for Xbox (You will need internet access on a separate computer/device for initial set-up.):

1. Create an account following the instructions above or if you have already created an account, sign into IndieFlix.
2. Once on the IndieFlix for Libraries site, go to the "My Account" page and click the "Activate Xbox" button on the upper right. This will generate an activation code for you to enter on your Xbox.
3. Power up your Xbox and on the Xbox home screen, select the "App" page. Browse Apps until you find IndieFlix and download the app.

4. Select the "Log In" tile on the home screen of the IndieFlix app. This will open a box for you to type in the activation code.
5. Enter the code and you're good to go!
6. Repeat these steps for multiple Xbox devices, as each Xbox will need to be connected to your IndieFlix membership.

Instructions for Roku Devices (You will need internet access on a separate computer/device for initial set-up.):

1. Create an account following the instructions above.
2. Power up your Roku device and select the IndieFlix channel. It is located in the Movies and TV section of the channel store.
3. Select "Add Channel" then go to the IndieFlix channel.
4. Choose any film and select "Watch Full Film". **This will bring up your activation code.**
5. Going back to your computer or mobile device, access the IndieFlix for Libraries site using the link above or on our Downloads page. Sign into IndieFlix.
6. On the IndieFlix for Libraries site, click the "My Account" button (bottom left corner).
7. On the "My Account" page, you will see an "Activate Your Roku/Xbox" button on the upper right. Click the "Roku" button.
8. Enter your activation code.
9. You're good to go! You only need to set-up the Roku once. Add IndieFlix for Libraries to your channels.
10. If you have more than one Roku device, you will need to follow the set-up instructions for each unit as each has a separate activation code.
